London Health Sciences Foundation is proud to report that last year (fiscal 2016), every dollar we invested to raise funds returned over \$3.50

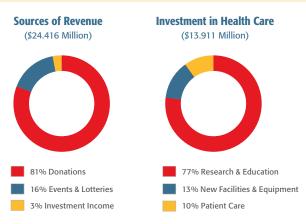
